#### HOMELESSNESS ACTION PROJECT LAUNCHES IN F.N.

The Fort Nelson Community Literacy Society is now overseeing the Homelessness Action Project, a communitybased initiative aimed at raising awareness about homelessness and supporting those experiencing or at risk of precarious housing. This project is designed to reduce stigma, improve access to resources, and strengthen partnerships within our region.

Over the coming months, the project team will develop two kev tools:

- A social and print media campaign to educate about the realities of homelessness
- Homelessness Community Resource Package, a toolkit that includes educational materials, local resource directories, and assessment tools. This toolkit will be designed to support individuals and can be accessible for use independently or with support.

We are funded by SPARC BC (Social Planning and Research Council of BC). We held our first community meeting in June, bringing together local organizations and voices to help shape the direction of this work. A second gathering is planned for fall. We hope to see you there!
